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WELFARE RIGHTS

Providing you and your family confidential advice around Benefits, Money, Advocacy, Support and more.

Recent casework has brought to our attention an error, where WIBSS funds were being taken into account in a care financial affordability check, despite there being legislation which states it should be discounted. In this instance, a local authority were including WIBSS funds when completing a financial assessment and consequently the person was being charged for care home fees. WIBSS assisted this individual in correcting this error by providing a written statement confirming the WIBSS payments should not be included. If you, or someone else you know may be in a similar situation, we are happy to help get this resolved.

This exemption, as always, also applies to means tested benefits, Income Tax, Housing Benefit and Council Tax Reduction schemes.
